

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE CORRANCE SCHOOL TRUST

1 April 2025 – 31 March 2026

The Corrance School Trust is registered with the Charity Commission, Charity No 1014386 and it was constituted by a Declaration of Trust on 6 January 1992.

The Trust obtained the funds from the sale of Parham School which closed in 1986. This Church of England School was set up in 1872 by Frederick Corrance, Esq. of Parham Hall. In recognition of this, the Diocese gave £12,838.98, which is kept as a permanent endowment. This endowment is for the educational and religious benefit of young persons up to the age of 25 living in Hacheston and Parham. Since that date, there have been further donations. The total amount on Deposit is £13,000 with the Cambridge and Counties Bank in a 5 year Fixed Rate Bond.

Interest received from the Cambridge & Counties Bank and on the HSBC Business Money Manager Account amounted to £615.90. Further money from ticket sales and donations were received from an evening talk and supper held at the Parham Airfield Museum on 12 September 2025. This amounted to £815. There were no expenses.

The Bank charges imposed by the Bank amounted to £25.00. This was a compulsory charge of £5 a month which was subsequently terminated. The Trustees approved 3 grants, totalling £190. All applications are treated in the strictest confidence.

The aims of the Trust are:

- a) To advance religious education in accordance with Christian principles and teaching amongst young people in the parishes of Parham and Hacheston
- b) To further opportunities in education and training for young people resident in the parishes of Parham and Hacheston
